2011 NOBEL PEACE PRIZE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES

The Norwegian Nobel Committee invites candidates for the **2011 Nobel Peace Prize Nomination** to be awarded on December 10, 2011.

Those who are entitled to submit their **unpublished proposals** are as follows:

- a. members of national assemblies and governments;
- b. members of international courts of law;
- c. university chancellors, university professors of social science, history, philosophy, law and theology; leaders of peace research institutes and institutes of foreign affairs;
- d. former Nobel Peace Prize laureates;
- e. board members of organizations that have received the Nobel Peace Prize;
- f. present and past members of the Norwegian Nobel Committee; (committee members must present their nomination during the first committee meeting after February 1.);
- g. former advisers at the Norwegian Nobel Institute; and
- h. members of institutions or associations.

(The Nobel Peace Prize may also be accorded to institutions or associations.)

The nominators are strongly requested not to publish their proposals.
