TRAINING PROGRAM ON SPEECH DEVELOPMENT

The Executive Teachers' Speech (School-Based) Training (ETST) Program enhances teachers' competence through vocal enrichment, visual vocabulary improvement, and pronunciation refinement.

The program aims to develop effective speech capabilities, proficiency and competence of high school students and teachers of English, Science, Mathematics, Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), Music, Arts, Physical Education (MAPEH) and Health Education and other subject areas that use English as the medium of instruction. It caters to a group of at least ten (10) teachers per subject area mentioned earlier. The training can be done in either one of the following options:

Option 1: Every Saturday (eight (8) hours)

Option 2: Three (3) days a week (eight (8) hours per day)

The program can be done during the summer months of April and May 2011 in the schools. A reasonable and a minimal amount of Nine Hundred Pesos (PhP900.00) registration fee shall be charged to each participant to cover the trainer's training fee, and a practice, and practicum workbook.

The training venue must accommodate at least fifty (50) participants. It must have a computer, LCD projector screen, sound system, and two (2) microphones with stand.
