### **2011 INTENSIVE LEADERSHIP CAMP**

The Saceda Youth Lead (SYL), a Youth Serving Institution under the auspices of the National Youth Commission (NYC) will hold its **2011 Intensive Leadership Camp** with the theme, "*Re-uniting the Filipino Youth for a Safer and Better Tomorrow*" from April 27 to May 3, 2011 at the SYL Center, Purok Gumamela, Candau-ay, 6200 Dumaguete City.

The activity aims to expose the participants to the current realities of the country in order to prepare them to take a lead role in the pursuit of social change.

The participants to this activity are the youth leaders in the elementary, high school and college levels, SG Advisers and those non-government organizations (NGOs) who are serving the youth.

For the teachers who will be joining the camp, a separate and intensive session will be undertaken by a select pool of facilitators and lecturers. They will also get a six (6) masteral units from Silliman University out of joining the camp as long as they would consistently and actively participate to meet all the requirements for camp graduation.

The registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) will be charged to each participant to cover full meals and accommodation, uniform, kits and full program on leadership and social action.
