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NATIONAL CHILDREN'S SCIENCE CONGRESS

The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI), ABS-CBN and AGHAM will hold the **National Children's Congress** with the theme, "*Trailblazing the Future through Science Learnings*", at the La Vista Pansol Resort, Calamba, Laguna on February 11-13, 2011.

The activity aims to (a) provide the participants with effective medium in the development of science and technology concepts; (b) undertake science activities that will enhance their creativity, understanding and exchange of novel ideas; (c) promote their academic excellence in science through scientific research; (d) instill in their minds an atmosphere of sound competition, camaraderie, sportsmanship; and (e) give recognition to researchers of science investigatory projects.

The registration fee which accounts for the accommodation from Day 0 to Day 3 and meals from dinner of Day 0 to lunch of Day 3 of the contestants, coaches and the Regional Elementary Science Supervisors is free. Other interested participants who are non-contestants will be charged with the registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) which will cover expenses for board and lodging.

Aside from medals and certificates, the winners will also receive a trophy for their school and cash prizes.

All write-up for the Science Investigatory Projects and Science Action Researches shall be sent for pre-judging to Prof. Evelyn Josue, Science Specialist, UP NISMED, UP Diliman, Quezon City before January 10, 2011.
