### **YOUTH CONFERENCE IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (YCIT) 2011**

The University of the Philippines Information Technology Training Center (UP ITTC), the UP System IT Foundation (UPSITF), and the UP Department of Computer Science (UP DCS) will hold the **6<sup>TH</sup> Youth Conference on I.T. (YCIT)** on February 18-19, 2011 at the UP Film Institute Diliman, Quezon City with the theme, **“Think IT, Do IT”**.

The YCIT aims to expose young IT enthusiasts to technological ventures; promote access to knowledge sources; and provide an overview of the current ICT trends and learning opportunities for the advancement of Information Technology.

The school officials, teachers, and students from the National Capital Region (NCR) are expected to attend this event. Prominent IT leaders from the industry, academe and government will also grace the occasion to share their expert view on the different topics for the 6<sup>th</sup> YCIT.

The registration fee which will be charged to each participant, is as follows: Early Bird Registration (until January 17, 2011): Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP250.00)/day/participant; Bulk Registration: Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP250.00)/day/participant; Regular Registration (until February 16, 2011): Three Hundred Pesos (PhP300.00)/day/participant; and Walk-in Registration: Four Hundred Pesos (PhP400.00)/day/participant.

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
