In celebration of the National Science Club Month this September pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 264, the National Science Club Month and the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) in coordination with the ABS-CBN-DZMM will hold the **National Science Club Month Seminar-Workshop for Science Club Leaders** with the theme "*Science Clubbing: A Strategic Contingency for Survival,*" on September 27-30, 2011 at the Abardeen Court, Quezon Avenue, Quezon City.
