TRAINING-WORKSHOP IN DEVELOPING AND MANAGING  
CURRICULUM INNOVATIONS

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. One of the functions of the school in decentralized setting as stipulated in R.A. No. 9155 is managing the curriculum. To assist school heads in the performance of their function as curriculum managers, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), shall conduct a two (2)-cluster Training-Workshop in Developing and Managing Curriculum Innovations.

2. The schedules of the training are as follows:

3. The training workshop aims to enhance the competencies of school heads/head teachers as curriculum managers specifically in relation to: a) developing and nurturing the culture of innovation; b) designing and piloting curriculum innovations; c) monitoring and evaluating pilots; and d) institutionalizing and scaling up curriculum innovations.

4. Participants to the training workshop are the Secondary Education (SED) chiefs and assistant chiefs, and the school heads/head teachers in the following types of schools per region, distributed as follows: a) six (6) from general high schools; b) two (2) from science-oriented high schools; and c) two (2) from technical vocational high schools. Likewise, school heads and head teachers from private schools are encouraged to participate in the training.
