64TH COMMEMORATION OF THE ARAW NG KAGITINGAN
AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 466, Declaring the Period of April 5 to 11 of Every Year as "Philippine Veterans Week" and Memorandum Order No. 205, the Department of National Defense (DND) was tasked to spearhead the 64th Commemoration of the Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week with the theme "Beterano at Salinlahi Kailangan sa Panahon ng Pagsubok." This will be in coordination with the government agencies and non-government organizations and associations for the duration of the celebration.
2. The celebration aims to promote, preserve and memorialize the principles, ideals and heroic deeds of the Filipino veterans and to uphold the democratic principles and nationalistic ideals of the war veterans as a means to enhance patriotism and love of country, especially among the youth.
3. DepED being a member of the National Inter-Agency Task Force (NATIF) encourages all DepED regional, division, and school officials to hold meaningful and fitting activities with the participation of students in both public and private schools. The Program of Activities, List of Regional Special Events Coordinators, List of VFP-SDAI Regional Vice-Presidents, and List of Regional Secondary Social Studies Supervisors are enclosed.
4. The Veterans Federation of the Philippines-Sons and Daughters Association, Inc. (VFP-SDAI) is sponsoring a National Oratorical Contest focusing on the theme of the celebration. The regional contest shall be managed by the VFP-SDAI Regional Vice-Presidents or the Post District Presidents in coordination with the DepED Division/Regional Special Events Coordinator. Expenses incurred during the conduct of the contest (division/regional/national levels) shall be charged to VFP-SDAI funds.
