SECOND NATIONAL ICTs IN BASIC EDUCATION CONGRESS


To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. This Department, in partnership with the Foundation for Information Technology Education and Development, Inc. (FIT-ED) and the Commission of Information and Communications Technology - Human Capital Development Group (CICT-HCDG) shall conduct the **Second National ICTs in Basic Education Congress** with the theme "**Innovating with Technologies: The Challenge to Education Policy and Management**" on September 6-7, 2006 at Cebu Waterfront Hotel, Lahug, Cebu City.
2. The Congress aims to promote more strategic and systematic decision-making and planning at the national and local levels on the role of ICTs in basic education system within the larger framework of quality education for all.
3. The Congress will showcase success stories in the management of ICTs in schools through concurrent paper presentations. Interested parties are invited to submit paper presentations on experiences in initiating, managing and sustaining ICT-based programs and projects in schools and in the alternative learning environments. Enclosed are the requirements and procedures for the submission of paper presentations.
4. Participants to the Congress are selected Regional Officials (Director, ICT Coordinator, Planning Officer and Finance Staff), Division Officials (Superintendent, ICT Coordinator, Planning Officer, Finance Staff, two (2) Elementary School Principals and two (2) Secondary School Principals). The Regional ICT Coordinators shall consolidate the official regional list of participants and submit to the Congress Secretariat. Members of the Secretariat who are from the Department shall attend **on official business**.
5. A registration fee of Three Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (PhP3,300.00) for public school officials and Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) for participants from private schools and institutions shall be charged. The registration fee shall cover the costs of the kit, two (2) lunches and four (4) snacks.
6. Public and private school participants who will register on or before July 31, 2006 will be given a discount of Six Hundred Pesos (PhP600.00) and Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00), respectively. Enclosed is the Registration Form which may also be downloaded online at [www.pilipinasschoolnet.net](http://www.pilipinasschoolnet.net).
7. Participants are advised to make their own arrangements with their preferred hotel on or before August 1, 2006 to avail of special rates. Enclosed is the list of official hotels of the Congress.

8. Traveling and other incidental expenses including the registration fee of public school participants shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. On the other hand, participants coming from private schools shall make their own arrangements.
