16TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PAMBANSANG SAMAHAN
PARA SA EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAHALAGA (PSEP Inc.)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Pambansang Samahan para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (PSEP), Inc. will hold its 16th Annual National Convention from November 29 to December 1, 2006 at St. Martin's Apartelle, M. Roxas St., Baguio City with the theme "Likas Kayang Pag-unlad sa Hamon ng Globalisasyon".
2. The aims of the convention are to:
 - a. develop awareness in the teachers' role in meeting the challenges of globalization;
 - b. initiate school-based programs for sustainable development; and
 - c. enhance students' creative participation in the promotion and preservation of moral and cultural values through different contests.
3. The Association will also hold its 4th Tagis Talino and Sayawit sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga Competitions and the 2nd On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest during the convention.
4. The 2006-2007 Winners for the Search for Outstanding School-Based Values Education Program, VE Supervisor, VE Educator and Model K-PSEP organization will also be awarded. The guidelines and mechanics of the contests and searches are enclosed.
5. Participants to this convention are VE and Makabayan regional, division and district supervisors, principals, teachers-in-charge, VE and Makabayan department heads, coordinators, subject area teachers both in the elementary and secondary, guidance counselors, PSEP and KPSEP national and local officers and members, PTCA officers, students and other interested parties.
6. A registration fee of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP3,800.00) for the PSEP and Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) for the KPSEP will be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, food, convention materials, certificates, honoraria of speakers and other incidental expenses, chargeable against

local funds/PTCA funds/School Board Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Principals are encouraged to send participants to the convention and contests. The Division and Regional VE/Makabayan Supervisors/Coordinators shall undertake the coordination in the field pertaining to their respective delegation and representation.


8. Student-participants to the convention and contests shall be given enough time to prepare for the quizzes and other examinations, which they may have missed because of their absence. In the same manner, student-participants shall be allowed reasonable time to comply with the other requirements of the different subject areas.

9. Officers of PSEP and the Organizing Committee and the Secretariat are authorized to travel two (2) days before the start of the convention.

10. The first meal of the convention shall be dinner on November 28, 2006, 6:00-8:00 pm only. In view of this, participants are requested to register before the said time.

11. Pre-registration and registration can be made on or before November 20, 2006. **ANNOUNCING THE 4TH PSEP Inc.'s TAGIS TALINO & SAYAWIT
SA EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAHALAGA**

Theme: *"Likas Kayang Pag-unlad sa Hamon ng Globalisasyon"*

November 29 , 30 & December 1, 2006

St. Martin 's Apartelle, M. Roxas St., Baguio City

Contest Mechanics for Tagis Talino , Sayawit & Poster Making:

1. Contestants must be registered Kabataang PSEP (K-PSEP) members at the National Level.
2. Each division could send at least one to three (1-3) competing teams (TAGIS TALINO, performing groups (SAYAWIT) and 3 participants (ON –THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING).
3. In case that there are more than three teams in a division, elimination should be done to meet mechanics #2. Participants coming from state universities and local colleges are considered national contestants and need not participate in the division elimination.
4. Each competing team should submit to the PSEP Inc. Secretariat a c certification duly signed by the school principal /head bearing the names of the contestants and their alternates and the name of the trainers/coaches with their full mailing address and contact numbers ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 10, 2006

Rules of the Contest - TAGIS TALINO

1. The teams will compete in the EASY (1 pt.) AVERAGE (3pts.), and DIFFICULT (5 pts.) categories.
2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the contents of the Values Education I-IV.
3. The quiz master will read the questions twice and the team contestants will be given 15 seconds to write the answer on the flash card then waits for the quiz master's signal to raise their answers. The scorers will be declared as winners (champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up).
4. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask another three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.
5. Cash Prizes and Trophies await the winners

Rules of the Contest – SAYAWIT

1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the congress theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes including entrance, exit and other stage preparations.
3. Number of participants should be from 7-10 singers and dancers who are dancing and singing at the same time (Technical Assistants are excluded)
4. Contestants may use props and other stage sets.
5. Live accompaniment is required and no lip synch.
6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.

Criteria for Judging

1. Concept relevance to the theme	-	20%
2. Choreography and staging	-	30%
3. Musicality	-	30%
4. Props, costumes, audio-visual effects	-	20%

Rules of the Contest- ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING

1. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials:
 - a. ¼ illustration board
 - b. pencil; and
 - c. pastel/craypas
2. Contestants are given 3 hours time allotment to finish their work.
3. Lettering and borders are not allowed as part of the presentation.

Criteria for Judging

1. Relevance to the theme	-	40%
2. Creativity	-	20%
3. Originality	-	20%
4. Visual Impact	-	20%

Rationale and Objectives: To recognize the outstanding achievements and efforts of schools and institutions in sustaining and strengthening the National Values Education Program.

Guidelines for Implementation: The search is open to all secondary schools in both public and private duly nominated by their respective division head using the prescribed nomination form.

Awards and Prizes

The winner shall receive the following awards and prizes:

1. A Plaque of Recognition for the School Awardee and its Division.
2. Cash prize of **P10,000.00** for the winning school.

*The awarding ceremony will coincide with the **Values Education Convention** on November, 2006.*

Qualification of Nominee

1. The school nominee must be presently offering Values Education both as a separate subject area and as integrated in the core subjects for the last three (3) years or more.
2. The school nominee must be recommended by the Division. Only one nominee per division will be accepted by PSEP.

Selection Procedure:

1. For the first level. All supporting documents (within the last three (3) years) submitted by the school nominees shall be rated according to a set of criteria presented below:

Outstanding Implementation of the Values Education Program - - - 25%
(well-managed VE program, introduced innovations in teaching VE, conducted researches, prepared instructional materials in VE and received awards and recognition)

Faculty Professional Development Program - - - - - 25%
(qualified teaching staff, provided professional development program, attended Values Ed. training programs, members of PSEP)

Student Development Program - - - - - 25%
(well organized K-PSEP group, supported various students activities – youth fora, seminar convention, etc.)

Community Involvement and School Leadership - - - - - 25%
(conducted and participated in community projects and reach out programs, mobilized the community for Values Development)

PSEP Annual Nationwide Search for Outstanding Values Educators

Rationale and Objectives: To recognize the outstanding achievements of Values Education teachers and to encourage others in the field to uplift the quality of teaching Values Education in the country.

Guidelines for Implementation: The search is open to all full-time Values Education department heads and teachers in the elementary, secondary and tertiary schools both public and private duly nominated by their respective school heads and using the prescribed nomination form.

Awards and Prizes

The winner shall receive the following awards and prizes:

1. A Plaque of Recognition for the Awardee and the school he/she comes from.
2. Cash prize of P5, 000.00 for each winner in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels.

The awarding ceremony will coincide with the **Values Education Convention** on November, 2006.

Qualification of Nominee

1. The nominee must be a Filipino citizen, male or female, presently teaching VE and must have taught Values Education in the elementary, secondary or tertiary level, whether in public or private school, for three (3) consecutive years or more.
2. The nominee for the award must be recommended by the school head. Only one nominee per division will be accepted by PSEP.
3. The nominee must be of good moral character as certified by the school head.
4. The nominee must not be presently an Officer or Board Member of PSEP.
5. Nominees and Finalists in last year's search (except the winners) are still qualified for re-nomination.

Selection Procedure:

1. For the first level. All supporting documents submitted by the nominees shall be rated according to a set of criteria presented below:
