1.  Date: October 20-23, 2006
- d. 44th National Rizal Youth Leadership Institute
 Venue: Benitez Hall, Senior Mess, Teachers Camp,
 Baguio City
 Date: December 17-21, 2006

2. The theme of the Institute is "Rizalism: Key to Global Peace, Solidarity and Prosperity".

3. An annual undertaking of the Order of the Knights of Rizal, the Institute seeks to imbue the student participants with the tenets of leadership, character building and sense of national vision. The program also provides a forum to discuss current issues within the context of Rizal's philosophy and conference. It also highlights different contests such as: On-The-Spot Essay Writing, Extemporaneous Speaking, Oratorical and Rizal Quiz contests.

A conference fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) for the three (3) Regional Institutes and Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) for National Conference per delegate and shall cover the registration fee, board and lodging for the abovementioned dates, convention I.D. and kit and a Certificate of Participation.
