6th PHILIPPINE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPALS CONGRESS

To: Regional Directors

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) in coordination with the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) will hold its 6th Philippine Elementary School Principals Association's Congress at Manila Pavilion on April 27-28, 2007. The theme of the Congress is "Re-Imagining the 21st Century School Leadership".

2. The objectives of the Congress are to:

- a. encourage best efforts in networked leadership across schools to raise achievement;
- b. require teacher leadership at the highest order through professional knowledge and skills; and
- c. ensure the use of appropriate technologies in redesigning curriculum and infrastructure of schools.
