
**CLUSTER ORIENTATION-TRAINING ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF
PHILIPPINE INFORMAL READING INVENTORY (PHIL-IRI)**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education shall conduct the Cluster Orientation-Training on the Administration of the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) in June-July 2007. The training is in support of the Every Child A Reader Program (ECARP) of the Department which aims to orient and train the regional and division English and Filipino Supervisors in all regions and divisions for standard administration and utilization of the Phil-IRI assessment tools.
2. The expected participants to this activity are the Regional and Division English and Filipino Supervisors nationwide (17 regions and 187 divisions). The schedules of the training are listed below while specific venues shall be announced later.

4. Participants are expected to check in at the venue not earlier than 2:00 pm a day before the training. First meal will be served at dinner.
