FINALIZATION OF THE COMPETENCY-BASED CURRICULUM OF THE STRENGTHENED
TECH-VOC EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. In view of the implementation of the Tech-Voc Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) in selected Tech-Voc High Schools for School Year 2007-2008, the Department of Education (DepED) conducted series of workshops to strengthen the Revised Technical Vocational Education (RTVE). The first was the conduct of the consultative conference with regional directors, Tech-Voc regional supervisors and Vocational School Administrators (VSA) on strengthening the RTVE last April 10-11, and second was the conduct of the curriculum writing workshop on the Tech-Voc Competency-Based Curriculum last April 23-28, 2007.
2. In line with this, the DepED, through the Tech-Voc Task Force, will conduct a two-day workshop to finalize the competency-based curriculum of the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program at the Marikina Hotel, Marikina City on May 21-22, 2007.
3. The objectives of the two-day workshop are to:
 - a. review the draft Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC), Contextual Learning Matrix (CLM), and Class Program of the 18 TVE subject areas which were the outputs during the six-day curriculum writeshop;
 - b. finalize the integration of core subject areas in the Tech-Voc CLM
 - c. come up with the final copy of the Competency-Based Curriculum of the Strengthened Tech-Voc Education Program.
4. Participants to the two-day workshop will be chosen from among the curriculum writers during the six-day writing workshop: two (2) representatives for Fishery; eight (8) for Arts and Trades; three (3) for Agriculture; eleven (11) for English; eleven (11) for Math; and eleven (11) for General Science, Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Also included in the workshop are representatives from SEAMEO INNOTECH, Technical Education Skills and Development Authority (TESDA), Education Program Specialists for English, Math, General Science, Biology, Chemistry and Physics from the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), Tech-Voc Task Force and secretariat.
5. Board and lodging, transportation and honoraria of participants and other incidental expenses shall be charged against Tech-Voc funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
