

On the other hand, participants to the Consultation and Validation with Stakeholders are experts from academe, heads/representatives from NGOs and GOs.

4. Board and lodging of participants (in all activities) and BSE staff, transportation, supplies and materials and extra duty allowance of BSE staff and other related expenses shall be charged against BSE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
