2008 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR TEACHERS ON HEARING
IMPAIRMENT, MENTAL RETARDATION AND LEARNING DISABILITY

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education (DepED), in coordination with Christoffel Blindenmission, International (CBMI) is sponsoring Training Programs for Teachers of Hearing Impaired, Teachers of Children with Mental Retardation and Teachers of Children with Learning Disability for Summer 2008. The training programs will be held at the following designated institutions in the three geographical areas on dates specified:

Luzon Area : Philippine Normal University (PNU)
Taft Avenue, Manila
April 14-May 8, 2008

Visayas Area : Cebu Normal University (CNU)
Osmena Blvd., Cebu City
April 14-May 9, 2008

Mindanao Area: Holy Cross College of Davao City
Sta. Ana Avenue, Davao City
April 15-May 10, 2008

2. The training programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with hearing impairment, those with mental retardation and those with learning disabilities.

3. Teachers trained in the 2007 Summer Training Programs on Hearing Impairment, Mental Retardation and Learning Disability at the Philippine Normal University, Manila, Cebu Normal University, Cebu City and Holy Cross College of Davao of City, Davao City who have provided educational services to the hearing impaired, mentally retarded and learning disability are considered for the second summer training in 2008. Their names are listed in Enclosure Nos. 2A, 2B and 2C, respectively.

4. Tuition fee, stipend and travel expenses to and from the venue shall be borne by the sponsoring agency. Likewise, participants to these training programs are advised to travel by sea or land.

5. The Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (see Enclosure No. 1) shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education DepED Central Office, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City not later than March 29, 2008.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

3. Conduct himself/herself in such a manner so as not to bring disgrace or dishonor for himself/herself, his/her school/agency and the Christoffel Blindenmission Inc.;

4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education at the end of the training a copy of his/her action plan;

5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;

6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing impaired, mentally retarded and learning disabled;

7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training;
8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Christoffel Blindenmission International such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine Government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the hearing impaired, mentally retarded and hearing disabled for two (2) years after each summer training; and
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
