2008 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education, (DepED) in coordination with the Philippine Normal University (PNU), Cebu Normal University (CNU) and the University of Southeastern Philippines (USEP), Davao City, will conduct the Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired. This is sponsored by the Resources for the Blind, Inc., Christoffel Blindenmission, Dark and Light Foundation and the Hildeshimer Foundation. The training will be held on the following dates and venues:

Luzon Area	: Philippine Normal University (PNU) Taft Avenue, Manila April 14-May 9, 2008
Visayas Area	: Cebu Normal University (CNU) Cebu City April 14-May 9, 2008
Mindanao area	: University of Southeastern Philippines (USEP) Davao City April 7-May 2, 2008

2. The program aims to enhance competencies of teachers in providing educational services to visually impaired children in regular schools.

3. Priority participants/nominees in the three areas shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the visually impaired (Enclosure No. 1). The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2 shall screen the nominees. Deadline for submission of nominees is set on March 21, 2008. The nominees are advised to make a collect call to Mr. Randy Weisser or Mrs. Maricel Nolasco at tel. no. (02) 726-3021 for PNU (Luzon) participants; Ms. Baby Padasas or Joy Carigara at tel. no. (032) 232-2004 for CNU (Visayas) participants and to Ms. Amy Mojica or Ms. Jasmin Batao at tel. no. (082) 225-8937 to 38 for USEP (Mindanao) participants. The RISC shall submit the final list of nominees and the required documents to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before March 28, 2008.

4. Selected teachers who are recipients of the DepED-RBI Summer Training Programs in Summer 2006 and 2007 will be informed of their continuation (Enclosure No. 4). Only those teachers who are actually providing services to the visually impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue their training this summer 2008.

5. All grantees shall be entitled to free tuition fees and a month's stipend. Grantees from Regions I, II, III, IV-A, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, ARMM, CARAGA and CAR under the training program at the PNU, CNU, and USEP will receive a month's stipend of Two Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP2,400.00) while those from NCR, Cebu City and Davao City shall receive One Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP1,400.00). All grantees are advised to travel by land or sea. Travel expenses shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies.

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents, or call up tel. no. (02) 631-9993.

4. Is not more than 45 years.
5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother.
6. Has no administrative/criminal record.
7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment towards work, peers and students.
8. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses
9. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of daily stipend/ reimbursement of travel expenses
10. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
11. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.
