SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON KALAHI CULTURAL CARE-GIVING

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The National Commission on Culture and the Arts (NCCA) will conduct a live-out Seminar-Workshop on Kalahi Cultural Care-Giving for poverty alleviation on March 24-27, 2008 at Fort Santiago, Intramuros, Manila.
2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
 - a. promote peace and sustainable development which is planned/complemented by a festival that will harvest good examples of cultural care-giving to urban poor centers and marginalized groups throughout the country;
 - b. discuss the opening up of cultural care-giving to overseas Filipinos and their families; and
 - c. work out the entry of performance and media arts modules into the TESDA ladderized curriculum and the DepED alternative learning system as well as the underscoring of creative training for those undertaking teacher education, social work and cultural diplomacy.
3. The participants to this activity are the Regional Director or Regional Culture for the Arts Coordinator, one (1) junior student of Special Programs in the Arts (SPA), ten (10) management and staff from the Culture and the Arts Office, two (2) from the Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS), two (2) facilitators each from Region III and NCR, and one (1) facilitator from Region IV-A.
4. The cost of training, food, materials, speakers, etc. will be shouldered by the NCCA.
5. Other expenses relative to this activity shall be charged against OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. However, expenses of the regional and division participants shall be charged to local funds.
