1. In collaboration with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department, the Philippine Association of Secondary Education Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs (PASECAC) announces the schedule of the national bi-annual conference:

2. The conference theme is "Setting the Pace for Quality Education". This conference aims to: a) thresh out issues and concerns on the implementation of various BSE-DepED programs and projects; b) update field implementers on current developments in secondary education; c) share best practices of the top regions in the NAT/NCAE experiences, and regional initiatives in secondary education; d) discuss programs and projects initiated by each regional office; e) visit effective secondary schools of the host region; and f) address issues and concerns of the association.

3. The participants to the conference are the Secondary Education Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the sixteen (16) regions, BSE Director and Assistant Director of ARMM, Assistant Director, Division Chiefs/Assistant Chiefs and two (2) Education Program Specialists of BSE. The list of participants is enclosed. Attendance to this activity is on **official business**.

4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the cost of board and lodging. Other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. An advisory of each conference shall be issued prior to the scheduled dates. This will include reports to bring and present, the estimated time of arrival/departure, first and last meals and other reminders for the participants.
