- a. enhance and upgrade teachers competencies in teaching strategies, methodology, and pedagogy in contextualizing tech-voc subjects in English, Science, Math and Araling Panlipunan;
- b. identify strategies to promote learner-centered environments for tech-voc students; and
- c. provide hands-on experience in developing contextualized instructional module.
