TELEVISION MODULES FOR HIGH SCHOOL LITERATURE CLASSES

- The Foundation for Upgrading the Standard of Education (FUSE) has produced "Continuing Studies via Technology (CONSTEC) on Literature: A Telecourse for Students and Teachers of Literature," a series of 25-minute telelessons meant to enhance the teaching of literature in secondary schools.
- 2. Each lesson is divided into two parts: the first segment is meant to be shown to students and focuses on a literary text, the second segment is meant to be watched by teachers and focuses on a method of teaching the text.
- 3. The series will be telecast by ABS-CBN's Knowledge Channel starting June 10, 2008, with one lesson being aired per week and repeated on the following time slots:

- All secondary school teachers handling English literature classes are advised to use the first segments of the telelessons in their classrooms as appropriate and to watch the second segments on how to teach literature using different pedagogical methods.
