### 2008 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

- 1. In celebration of the annual Literacy Week, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation and coordination with other Government Organizations (GOs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Private Organizations (POs) and Non-government Organizations (NGOs), will hold the National Literacy Conference for the year 2008 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on September 17-19, 2008. The theme of the conference is "Functional Literacy Towards a Sustainable Future".
- 2. The objectives of the conference are to:
  - a. examine the meanings of sustainable development/future;
  - b. assess opportunities and constraints in crafting and implementing literacy projects/programs addressed to the development of a sustainable future;
  - c. show how strategic communication may be used to encourage greater participation in literacy development and to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of literacy programs; and
  - d. share experiences in implementing literacy programs for sustainable development.
  - 3. The following participants are expected to attend the conference:
    - a. Bureau, center and regional directors or their representatives;
    - b. Bureau/regional chiefs, supervisors, coordinators and mobile teachers of the Alternative Learning System;
    - Schools division superintendents, (especially those from provinces with the lowest literacy rate), assistant schools division superintendents, supervisors, principals, head teachers;
    - d. Officers of other government agencies with extension programs involving literacy or continuing education;

e. Heads and members of non-government organizations (NGOs) involved in universalizing literacy in every region especially Rotarians;

f. Heads of local government units (LGUs) and officers involved in the universalization of literacy; (barangay

chairmen, kagawad and others)

g. Heads of private/corporate foundations with interest in education or literacy; and

h. Heads and members of academic institutions.

- 4. This is a live-in conference. Participants are requested to register on September 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Conference proper starts on September 18, 2008. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
- 5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits and other supplies and materials. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is understood that the Literacy Coordinating Council will pay the management of Teachers Camp the amount incurred for the board and lodging, rental of facilities and other services of the participants out of the proceeds of registration fees at the end of the conference.
