**CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL NON-SPECIALIST
TEACHERS IN FILIPINO, ARALING PANLIPUNAN, TECHNOLOGY
AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE) AND MUSIC, ARTS,
PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH (MAPEH) TERM 2**

To: **Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools**

1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and the Regional Offices, in partnership with the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) and Centers of Excellence (COEs), announces the offering of Term 2 of the Summer Certificate Program for Secondary School Non-Specialist Teachers in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH). Term 1 was conducted last Summer 2008.
2. The Certificate Program seeks to improve the capability of non-specialist teachers teaching any of the four (4) aforementioned learning areas by providing knowledge, skills and attitudes (KSAs) and experiences that will increase their knowledge of content and upgrade their competence in teaching and assessment for learning. Follow-through interventions at the division level are expected to be provided during the semestral break as part of the continuing capability-building of teachers.
3. The Certificate Program is a 24-unit, six-week course conducted in two (2) summers. Term I began last April 14, 2008 and ended on May 24, 2008. Term 2 shall begin on April 13, 2009 and shall end on May 23, 2009.
4. The selection of participants for Term 1 was done previously by the Regional Offices. The same participants shall undertake Term 2 in order to complete the program. No new participants shall be considered for Term 2. The lists of participants were provided to the different TEIs of the region. The qualification requirements include the following:
 - a. Graduate of teacher education or allied programs with less than 24 units in the subject area (Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, TLE and MAPEH);
 - b. With at least 5 years of teaching experience in any of the aforementioned subjects;
 - c. With a teaching assignment or load in the subject for the last three (3) years;

- d. Not more than 55 years of age and, if female, must not be pregnant;
- e. Must be eligible (PBET/LET passer) and with a permanent appointment;
- f. Must sign a training contract with the Schools Division Superintendent; and
- g. Must be free from any administrative liabilities.

The service providers for each subject area are listed in the enclosures.

5. Each participant shall be entitled to a stipend of Twelve Thousand Pesos (PhP 12,000.00), a book allowance of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.0) per summer training and a training fee of Eight Thousand Pesos (PhP8,000.00). Funds for the purpose shall be transferred to the Regional Offices.

6. Should a participant opt to earn undergraduate units from the program, he/she should present to the TEI/COE Permit to Study and the undergraduate Transcript of Records (TORs) and other requirements. Otherwise, only a Certificate of Completion shall be awarded each participant.
