**2010 NATIONAL LEVEL DEPED-INTEL PHILIPPINE SCIENCE FAIR**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in collaboration with Intel Technology Philippines, Inc. (ITPI) will conduct the **2010 National Level DepEd-Intel Philippines Science Fair (DepEd-IPSF)** on February 15-17, 2010 at the Bahay ng Alumni, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City. This year's theme is *"Mentoring Tomorrow's Innovators"*.
2. This activity aims to:
  - a. enhance the capability of students to conduct scientific researches thereby promoting science and technology consciousness among high schools students; and
  - b. identify the most creative and the best science student researchers who shall represent the country in the 2010 Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF).
3. The official participants shall only be the national level Scientific Review Committee (SRC)-approved Rank I Regional Winners of the individual and team projects with the team represented only by the project leader.
4. Enclosed are the guidelines (Enclosure No.1), schedule of activities (Enclosure No. 2) and the list of DepEd-IPSF Regional Coordinators (Enclosure No. 3).
5. Travel to and from the official stations to the venue including board and lodging of official participants and honorarium of identified members of the Board of Judges shall be charged against ITPI Funds. Whereas, travel to and from the venue and per diem of teacher adviser/coach, regional coordinators and BSE-DepEd staff shall be charged against local funds or other financial resources, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, while board and lodging of teacher advisers, regional coordinators and BSE-DepEd staff shall also be charged against ITPI Funds.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

**A. General Guidelines on the 2010 National Level DepEd-Intel Philippine Science Fair**

1. The guidelines issued in the *International Rules for Precollege Science Research : Guidelines for Science and Engineering Fairs 2009-2010* (downloadable at [www.societyforscience.org/isef/document/index.asp](http://www.societyforscience.org/isef/document/index.asp)) shall be strictly followed, especially the prohibition against plagiarism or intellectual dishonesty. Anyone found violating intellectual property rights shall be disqualified and dealt with accordingly.
2. There shall be two (2) clusters of participants, namely: Cluster 1 which includes the regular high schools from both private and public schools; Cluster 2 includes science high schools and classes that belong to the 112 S & T Oriented (ESEP) High Schools. If the student researcher is enrolled in a Special Science Class of an ESEP school, he/she shall be included in Cluster 2, but, if the student is enrolled in the regular class of an ESEP school, he/she shall be included in Cluster 1.
3. The decisions of the Science Review Committee (SRC) and the Board of Judges (BOJ) are final.

**B. Guidelines on the conduct of the DepEd-IPSF:**

1. *The activity starts with the registration of participants by cluster on February 15, 2010 and closes on February 17, 2010.*
  - 1.1 Participants shall register their projects with the Registration Committee before they can be allowed to put up their exhibits;
  - 1.2 The guidelines set in the Intel ISEF display and safety regulations shall be strictly observed;
  - 1.3 The project proponents for the individual projects and the project leader for the team project (however, other team members may be allowed) are expected to stay in their display booths especially during the on-site evaluation of the projects);
  - 1.4 All science fair participants and the project advisers are required to participate actively in all activities scheduled for them during the fair;
  - 1.5 All official participants are enjoined to follow the schedule on time. Everyone shall sign the attendance sheet every morning and afternoon throughout the duration of the science fair through their respective Regional Coordinator;

1.6 The BOJ has the authority to determine the number of project proponents who will join the science congress. During the Educators' Academy, the student researchers are requested to be with their exhibits for the last minute clarifications of the BOJ; and

1.7 Management shall not be responsible for any damage or loss in the exhibit booths.

2. *Re – travel to and from the venue, accommodation and food*

2.1 Intel Technology Philippines, Inc. shall shoulder the travel to and from the venue, accommodation and food of the official participants. These are the presenters of both the individual and team projects.

ITPI shall reimburse the travel expenses of the official participants to and from the venue of the IPSF.

Should the other 2 members of the project team or visitors (or both) from the region decide to attend the national fair, it shall be at their own expense.

2.2 Travel and per diem of teacher advisers/coaches, DepEd-IPSF Regional Coordinators and BSE-DepEd staff, shall be charged against local funds or other resources subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Whereas, board and lodging during the duration of the Science Fair shall be charged against ITPI funds.

2.3 Meals of the official participants, teacher advisers and Regional Coordinators and BSE-DepEd staff shall start with lunch on February 15, 2010 and end with lunch on February 17, 2010.

2.4 Official participants, teacher advisers/coaches, DepEd-IPSF Regional Coordinators and BSE/DepEd staff shall go directly to the venue for registration and putting up of exhibits.

2.5 During the On-Site Evaluation, only the official student participants with their team mates are allowed to be at the venue.

C. *House Rules*

1. Official participants should register in the hotel for their room assignments;

2. No participants shall be allowed to swap/exchange room assignments;

3. Participants are expected to observe proper decorum and dress code (not in school uniform) at all times;
4. Visitors/non-participants are not allowed inside the participants' room. Visitors should be entertained in the lounge or receiving area of the dormitory/hotel;
5. Curfew hours set by the venue shall be strictly followed. Should there be a need to stay beyond curfew hours, the hotel/dormitory management shall be notified beforehand;
6. Participants shall be accountable for any intentional damage or loss of property in their rooms; and
7. Participants are expected to strictly follow other specific house rules in their particular dormitory/hotel.
