ORIENTATION AND SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE REVISION OF MANUAL OF REGULATIONS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS

In line with the Department of Education's thrust of Revising the Manual of Regulations for Private Schools, the Association of the Private Schools of the Philippines, in coordination with the Private Secondary Schools Administrators Association of the Philippines (PRISSAAP), National Association of Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NASSPHIL), Inc. and the Department of Education (DepEd) will hold a National Orientation and Seminar-Workshop on the Formulation and Revision of Manual of Regulations for Private Schools on the following dates and venue:

- 2. The objective of this activity is to revisit, review and improve the existing Manual of Regulations for Private Schools.

Participants to this live-in seminar-workshop are Schools Division Superintendents, Legal Officers, Administrative Officers, Pre-Elementary, Elementary and Secondary Schools Principals/Administrators, Education Supervisors in-Charge of Private Schools, School Owners of Private Schools and Regional and Division School-Based Management (SBM) Coordinators.
- 4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 2,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, materials and other seminar expenses. Meals to be served include two (2) snacks (pm/am and one (1) dinner, breakfast and lunch.
