**NATIONAL BI-ANNUAL CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE OF SECONDARY
EDUCATION DIVISION CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS**

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department, in collaboration with the Philippine Association of Secondary Education Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs (PASECAC) announces the schedules of the national bi-annual conference:

2. The conference aims to:

- a. identify critical performance indicators and situationer for both the learners and the teachers;
- b. formulate alternative schemes for the improvement of critical performance indicators for the focus groups;
- c. prepare a unified implementation and monitoring plan responsive to thrusts and concerns of secondary education;
- d. generate policy recommendations to improve performance indicators;
- e. be updated on the current BSE programs and projects;
- f. visit selected secondary schools that implement variety of innovations; and
- g. address issues and concerns of the association.

3. The participants to the conference are the Secondary Education Division (SED) Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the sixteen (16) regions, BSE Director of ARMM, the BSE Directors III and IV, Officers-in-Charge of the Curriculum Development Division (CDD) and Staff Development Division (SDD), and two (2) Education Program Specialists of BSE (list enclosed). Attendance to this activity shall be on **official business**.

4. The SED Chiefs who are assigned to other divisions due to restructuring are authorized to attend.

5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the cost of board and lodging. Other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



6. The participants are requested to bring with them the data/statistics on their regional performance indicators for the last three (3) years (SY 2006-2009), a summary list of least learned skills in all learning areas, and targets for the next ten (10) years (SY 2010-2020) as basis in planning the intervention and strategies to address the needs/gaps identified. The data should be disaggregated by gender, geographical location, and cultural grouping, where applicable.
