

### 4TH NATIONAL CONGRESS ON ICTS IN BASIC EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public Elementary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in partnership with the Foundation for Information Technology Education and Development, Inc. (FIT-ED) and the University of the Philippines College of Education (UPCEd), will conduct the **Fourth National Congress on ICTs in Basic Education** with the theme, "Creating Opportunities for Better Pupil Participation" on October 27-28, 2010 at the Henry Lee Irwin Theater, Ateneo de Manila University, Loyola Heights, Quezon City.
- 2. The objectives of this two-day event are to:
  - a. provide a forum for stakeholders to discuss key issues and share good practice models of ICT-based innovations at the elementary level within the framework of providing quality basic education for all; and
  - b. gain insights on how ICT can be transformed to opportunities for better pupil participation and learning and for teacher development.
- 3. The participants to this activity are the following:
  - a. Regional Officials
    - Chief or Assistant Chief, Elementary Education Division
    - ICT Coordinator
  - b. Schools Division/City Officials
    - SDS or ASDS
    - one (1) ES I
  - c. Elementary Schools Officials/Personnel
    - two (2) principals per division
    - two (2) subject area teachers per division
- 4. The division should choose personnel from schools with existing computer laboratories/e-classrooms or those who are intending to set-up such laboratories/e-classrooms. The Regional ICT Coordinators shall consolidate the official lists of participants in their respective regions and submit to the Congress Secretariat.
- 5. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP1,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover congress kit, lunch and snacks for two (2) days, and participation in all plenary and concurrent sessions. Please see the registration form and guidelines on how to register in Enclosure No. 1, which can also be downloaded at <a href="https://www.fit-ed.org/congress2010">www.fit-ed.org/congress2010</a>. On-line registration will be available from September 27 to October 18, 2010. Only 450 slots are available, and participants will be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis.



- 6. Due to limited slots, the DepEd participants will be guaranteed the same upon remittance of their registration fees. Updates on the number of available slots will be posted regularly on the Congress website: www.fit-ed.org/congress2010.
- 7. Participants are advised to make their own arrangements for accommodations. Please see Enclosure No. 2 for the list of hotels and hostels near the Congress venue, which can also be downloaded at the given website.
- 8. Travel, accommodation and registration fee of public school participants shall be charged to local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
