- 1. The AFS Intercultural Philippines Programs is pleased to announce the qualifiers/scholars for the **2010 Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths (JENESYS) Scholarship Programs** per DepED Memorandum No. 79, s. 2010 entitled, "2010 AFS Intercultural Programs Philippines Selection Camps."
- 2. The AFS Intercultural Programs Philippines is sending Filipino high school students and teachers to participate in the following 2010 JENESYS Scholarship Programs in Japan for intercultural exchange, study tours, home stay with Japanese families:

- 3. Please see enclosed lists for the qualifiers/scholars and their alternates.
- 4. All qualifiers/scholars for the (a) JENESYS VS Country Mix Program, (b) JENESYS VS ASEAN Mix Program and (c) JENESYS Year Program (YP) are required to report to **OMI Retreat Center, Manga St., Mapayapa Village I, Quezon City** on December 1, 2010 for the pre-departure orientation.
- 5. Upon their arrival from Japan, qualifiers/scholars for the JENESYS VS Country Mix Program and JENESYS VS ASEAN Mix Program shall stay in the same venue until December 17, 2010 for the re-entry activities.



- 6. Travel of these scholars (students and teachers) shall be on **official business**. Travel expenses of public school teachers and students to and from Manila, and other necessary and incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds, or local school board funds. They can also solicit from local government units (LGUs) subject to auditing and accounting rules and regulations. All expenses incurred during their stay in Japan shall be shouldered by the Japanese government.
- 7. Students, both from public and private high schools, participating for the JENESYS VS Country Mix Program and JENESYS VS ASEAN Mix Program shall be excused from their classes and given enough time to prepare for quizzes and other examinations missed during their absence. They shall also be allowed reasonable time to comply with and submit other requirements of the different subject areas.
- 8. Students, both from public and private high schools, participating for the JENESYS Year Program (YP), shall be given a special arrangement and an advanced schedule in fulfilling and completing the various requirements for graduation at least three (3) weeks before departure.
- 9. All regional directors (RDs), schools division/city superintendents (SDSs), and school heads are advised to generously support their respective students and teachers for quality participation, representation and learning.
