1. The Leaders in Education Programme International (LEPI) announces its **4th Annual Conference for Leaders in Education Programme International (LEPI)** with the theme, "*Global Trends and Issues in School Leadership*" on December 3-4, 2010 at the Ateneo de Manila School Auditorium, Loyola Heights, Quezon City.

2. The international conference aims to build leadership capacity in schools by enabling participants to:

- a. learn about global trends and issues in educational leadership and school development and innovations;
- b. learn about leading schools in times of rapid and unpredictable change;
- c. be inspired by the works of education practitioners who led and transformed their schools and achieved dramatic improvement in their students' performance; and
- d. network with educators from the different countries and various educational institutions for possible partnership and collaboration in future projects and/or activities.

3. The participants to this conference are officials of DepEd central, regional and schools division offices, heads of public and private schools including department heads and head teachers, coordinators, moderators, supervisors and schools principals.



4. The registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover meals (2 lunch, and 4 snacks), conference kit (conference bag or envelope, conference manual, ID, notepad, pen and handouts), and certificates. The organizers have offered to subsidize the registration fee of DepEd officials and public school leaders by more than sixty percent (60%) of the regular conference fee. All other expenses relative to this activity shall be borne by the participants.

5. The participants outside Metro Manila are advised to peruse the enclosed list of recommended hostels, their accommodation rates and contact information. They are expected to check-in a nearby hostel a day before the start of the conference. The participants are encouraged to directly contact the hostel of their choice to arrange for their accommodations during the duration of the conference.

6. The participants are expected to arrive in the conference venue not later than 8:00 a.m. of December 3. The conference will end at 5:00 p.m. of December 4, 2010.

7. For reservation, all concerned participants are requested to deposit their registration fees with any branch of Bank of Philippine Islands (BPI) to Ateneo de Manila University Savings Account No. 3081-0006-29 with Swift Code **BOIPHMM**. The original BPI deposit slip shall be presented to the Registration Committee on the first day of the conference for the issuance of Official Receipt (OP).

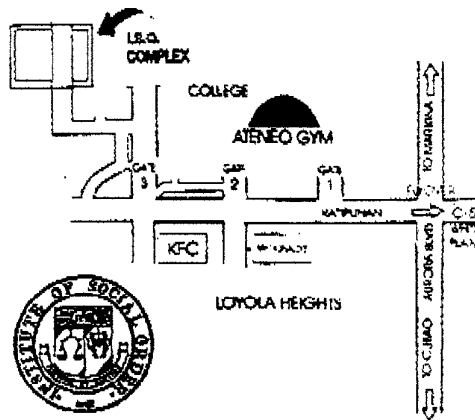
