NATIONAL FEDERATION OF SUPREME STUDENT GOVERNMENTS (NFSSG) CONFERENCE

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepEd-CSCA) will conduct the **National Federation of Supreme Student Governments (NFSSG) Conference** on January 17-21, 2011 at the Philippine Tourism Authority-Gardens of Malasag, Eco-Tourism Village, Cugman, Cagayan de Oro City, Region X.
- 2. As a ready mechanism for student consultations and as a source of policy recommendations, the NFSSG Conference aims to achieve the following:
 - a. Evaluate, identify and resolve issues pertinent to the implementation of the Student Government Program (SGP);
 - b. Discuss, consult and design strategies to encourage support for the K+12 Program;
 - c. Evaluate the impact, gather feedback on, and review the implementation of the following pertinent issuances/programs:
 - (1) DepED Order No. 79, s. 2009 (Revised Standard Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Student Governments in Secondary Schools);
 - (2) DepED Order No. 92, s. 2009
 (Revised Guidelines on the Selection of Honor Pupils and Students in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools);
 - (3) School-Based Management.
 - d. Consult on other possible SSG-related DepED issuances to strengthen the Student Government Program (SGP), to wit:
 - (1) Constitution and By-Laws of the Federations of Supreme Student Governments (SSG);
 - (2) Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Pupil Governments (SPG);
 - (3) Guidelines on the Synchronized Elections of School-Based Co-Curricular Organizations;
 - (4) Guidelines on Students' Officership and Membership in School-Based Co-Curricular Organizations;
 - (5) Supreme Pupil/Student Governments Awards;
 - (6) Election Code of the SSGs; and



- (7) Constitution and By-Laws of the Federations of SSG Advisers;
- e. Update on the implementation of programs and projects which harness the student government as an effective partner in achieving quality education and academic excellence in schools;
- f. Assist the newly-elected officers of the National Federation of Supreme Student Governments (NFSSG) in the implementation of programs and projects; and,
- g. Improve efforts in making available real exposure, experience and learning in responsible and participative democracy and leadership.
- 3. The participants to this conference are the newly-elected officers of the NFSSG for School Year 2010-2011, *Araling Panlipunan* regional supervisors or the SGP regional coordinators, representatives from the SSG teacher-advisers, resource persons and facilitators, former NFSSG officers and DepEd-CSCA personnel. Enclosed is the List of Participants which serves as the travel authority and the Tentative Schedule of Activities as Enclosure Nos. 1 and 2 respectively). Participants are expected to be at the venue in time for lunch on January 17 until breakfast of January 21, 2011. The members of the DepEd-CSCA staff are authorized to travel one (1) day before and one (1) day after the conference.
- 4. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of *Araling Panlipunan* regional supervisors/SGP regional coordinators and SSG teacher-adviser representatives shall be charged to local funds and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expenses for board and lodging, supplies and materials of all participants, including transportation and other incidental expenses of former and newly-elected NFSSG officers, DepEd-CSCA personnel, resource persons, facilitators and guests shall be charged against DepEd-OSEC funds.
