**2017 ANNUAL NATIONWIDE SEARCH FOR YOUNG ARTS SCHOLARS
OF THE PHILIPPINE HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS**

1. The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), a government-run special secondary school for young artists, is conducting the **2017 Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS)**, hence it is now accepting applications for full Special K to 12 Secondary Scholarship for School Year 2017-2018.

2. The 2017 ANSYAS aims to:

- a. identify and develop artistically gifted and talented children to become artists of excellence in the fields of dance, music, theater and visual arts; and
- b. ensure a continuing source of artists of excellence and leaders in the preservation, conservation and promotion of the Filipino artistic and cultural traditions.

3. Applicants must be Filipino citizens who can meet the following requirements:

- a. Grade 6 pupil at the time of application in a public or private school;
- b. Not older than 14 years upon enrolment on June 10, 2017;
- c. Fully accomplished PHSA Scholarship Application Form;
- d. Photocopy of Birth Certificate issued by the National Statistics Office;
- e. Photocopy of Grade 5 or Grade 6 Report Card; and
- f. One-page resumé citing accomplishment in the art field of their respective interests.

4. The successful applicants will be awarded full scholarship which includes *free* tuition fee, *free* board and lodging (with weekend home leave with parents or a designated legal guardian), classes with master teachers, monthly stipend, *free* ticket to shows, events and performances at the Cultural Center of the Philippines, opportunity to get training, to meet and interact with outstanding world class artists, visiting foreign and chance to represent the country and the school in international festivals, competitions and exchange programs. The scholarship grant is renewable every year for four to six consecutive school years upon satisfaction of academic and nonacademic requirements.

5. Interested applicants may directly send their accomplished application forms and other requirements by mail, email, or by personally submitting them to the **Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS) Committee, Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA)**, National Center, Mt. Makiling, Los Baños 4030, Laguna. The PHSA Scholarship Form is enclosed.

Philippine High School for the Arts

The School

A government-run secondary school for artistically talented children, the Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) implements a special secondary education curriculum aimed at training and honing future artists and cultural leaders. Aside from academic and artistic training, PHSA provides students with opportunities to develop their social skills, contributing to their development as artists for others.

Search Objective

PHSA screens applicants yearly to identify, and give scholarships to artistically talented children, all over the Philippines. Applicants go through an audition process under the supervision of a audition master's to determine their skills and talent.

Scholarship Privileges

- Free tuition fee
- Board and lodging (with weekend home leave with parents or a designated legal guardian)
- Classes with master teachers
- Monthly stipend
- The chance to represent the country and the school in international festivals, competitions and exchange programs.
- The scholarship grant is renewable every year for 4 to 6 consecutive school years upon satisfaction of academic and non-academic requirements.

Curriculum

The Basic Education subjects prescribed by the Department of Education are in the PHSA curriculum - K-12. These subjects are handled creatively in support of the specialized studies for artistic expressions in the following disciplines:

- **Creative Writing:** Fiction, Poetry, Playwriting, and Journalism in English and Filipino
- **Dance:** Classical Ballet, Modern Dance, Philippine Folk Dance, Dance Composition and Staging
- **Music:** Solo Voice/Solo Instrument, Music Theory, Chamber Music, Music Performance Class

Scholarship Information

- **Theater Arts:** Theater Theory, Technical Theater and Production Design, Acting and Directing, Stage and Production Management
- **Visual Arts:** Visual Perception, Sculpture, Art Appreciation, Studio Painting, Materials and Techniques, Figurative, Pottery, and Printmaking

Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible for scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a Filipino citizen
- Be a Grade VI pupil at the time of application
- Not be older than 14 years upon enrollment on June 10 of the next school year

Document Requirements

- Fully accomplished PHSA Scholarship Application Form
- Photocopy of Birth Certificate issued by the NSO
- Photocopy of Grade V or Grade VI Report Card
- One-page resume citing accomplishments in the art field of interest

Audition Requirements

- **Creative Writing**
 - an episode of works (e.g., short story, poem, essay) in Filipino and/or English
 - Short bond paper and writing materials (pen, ball pen)

Ballet

- Complete ballet outfit
- Soft shoes and point shoes (point shoes only if needed)
- Music CD for prepared dance

Folk Dance

- Prepared dance number
- Music CD for prepared dance
- Proper outfit
- Girls: Knee-length loose skirt and sleeveless blouse
- Boys: Slim-fit shirt or sandalo and shorts or pants

Theater Arts

- One (1) 3-minute solo stage performance piece in English
- One (1) 3-minute solo stage performance piece in Filipino
- One (1) 3 to 5-minute movement piece and song
- Extra t-shirt

- **Visual Arts**
 - Portfolio (at least 10 works) in digital format (jpeg) in CD or DVD.
 - Bring 5 sets paper pencils (preferably 3B & 6B pencils), Any coloring materials prepared by applicants (watercolor, colored pencils, pastels, colored pencils, crayola)

Music

NOTE: Applicants must send a video recording of themselves performing their audition requirements, to be received by PHSA not less than 15 days before the live audition date. Each piece may be uploaded to YouTube separately, or sent in a CD/vid so tape format. (According to YouTube is highly recommended to avoid defective materials.)

Before performing each piece, the applicant must state his/her name, title of the piece, and the composer. Applicant's whole body must be visible while performing.
