#### FIRST NATIONAL CONVENTION ON CHILD-FRIENDLY TELEVISION

To: Undersecretaries **Assistant Secretaries** Bureau and Service Directors **Regional Directors** Schools Division Superintendents Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

The National Council for Children's Television (NCCT), an attached agency of the Department of Education (DepEd), will hold the First National Convention on Child-Friendly Television with the theme Limitless Media Access and Content: Reshaping the Perception of the iGeneration from November 21 to 23, 2018 at the Far Eastern University, Manila. This is pursuant to Republic Act No. 8370 entitled Children's Television Act of 1997, which mandates the NCCT to promote and encourage the production and broadcast of developmentally-appropriate television programs for Filipino children.

#### 2.. The convention aims to:

- a. determine the current state of the Filipino child,
- b. discuss relevant and prevailing issues on media and children,
- c. explore the significance of content creation in safeguarding
- d. acknowledge and understand the importance and impact of media (traditional and new media) on the holistic development of the Filipino children,
- e. raise awareness on the value and necessity of child-friendly television content and highlight the feasibility of producing quality television programs,
- f. encourage children (and the youth) to promulgate meaningful television content by exposing them to quality documentaries, and
- celebrate local talent and child-friendly television programs.
- Each region will send 15 participants comprising of: 3.
  - a. Five Grades 9 and 10 junior high school students, preferably from the Special Program for the Arts section, Campus Journalism, Supreme Student Government or Organizational Officers and Grade 11 senior high school students from the Humanities and Social Sciences strand;
  - b. Five elementary and high school teachers; and
  - c. Five parents, preferably Parents and Teachers Association

- 4. The highlight of the convention is the screening and awarding of NCCT's video documentary contest entitled *DokyuBata*: *Isang Pagdiriwang ng Dokumentaryong Pantelebisyon Para sa Batang Pilipino* with the theme Mental Health Matters: Promoting Awareness and Supportive Environments for the Wellbeing of Children.
- 5. The Video Documentary Contest is open to public and private elementary and secondary schools.
- 6. Each school division office is expected to submit at least but not limited to one *DokyuBata* entry. The deadline of submission will be on **October 10, 2018** at 5:00 p.m.
- 7. The mechanics of the contest is provided in the enclosure with supporting documents, guides, and requirements.
- 8. Free convention kits, admission and meals will be provided to the participants. Travel and accommodation expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9. The names of participants will be submitted to NCCT on or before **October 26, 2018**.

#### DokyuBata Festival 2018 Video Documentary Contest

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### **Eligibility**

- DokyuBata 2018 Video Documentary Contest is open to Filipino citizen ages 12 to 17 for Children Division and ages 18 to 23 for Young Adult Division.
- The production team must be composed of maximum of 10 members who may or may not belong to the same school, barangay, or organization.
- Participants are welcome to join the competition individually.

#### Guidelines

- Entries must be in a documentary genre, facts-based.
- Entries must revolve around the theme: "Mental Health Matters:
  Promoting Awareness and Supportive Environments for the Well-being of
  Children."
- Entries must be no shorter than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes for **Children Division** and 6 to 10 minutes for the **Young Adult Division**. (This includes Opening billboard and Closing credits. Please find the credits guide at the end of the document.)
- Videos must feature live footage and may or may not have dialogues or host.
- Dialogues in the videos may be in any vernacular; **English subtitles** however must be provided when the spoken language in the video is neither English nor Filipino.
- Videos must be originally shot using any kind of camera.
- The incorporation of positive Filipino values and/or local culture in the videos is highly encouraged.
- Entries must not feature offensive situations harmful to the dignity of children or any elements of violence, sex, crime, and abuse.
- The use of music or musical score is not required (should it be deemed essential, music or musical score used in the video **must be original**, i.e., composition of the production team or royalty free music, and duly cited in the credits.)
- Participants will be liable for any claim of infringement related to the materials included in the video.
- The production team does not include the cast of actors.
- The production team of the Children Division entries must have at least one supervising adult (e.g. parent, faculty member, barangay official/employee, organization officer), a person of legal age whose role

would be limited to logistical guidance (i.e., chaperone, minimal technical help, and guarantor of output's authenticity and compliance to fair use and copyright guidelines.)

- o However, minimal supervision from adults is requested in all stages of production so that the outputs may reflect genuine talent, skills, and worldview of the participants.
- No logo or watermark of any editing software shall be visible in the video.
- Once submitted, entries become the property of the National Council for Children's Television.
- The Council reserves the right to show the entries for educational and informational purposes in perpetuity.
- Documentaries must have been produced from January 2018 to September 2018.

#### Selection

• Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

Content/Message

8 points

Originality and Creativity

5 points

Adherence to the Theme

4 points

Overall Impact

3 points

Highest Possible Score 20 points

- A screening committee composed of the NCCT Secretariat and other qualified judges shall narrow down the entries into the Top 10 for both categories which will be shown during the Philippine National Convention on Child-Friendly Television.
- A board of judges that would include but not be limited to professional media practitioners, child rights, and mental health advocates, shall determine the best video and recipients of special awards from among the finalists. Their decision is final and irrevocable.
- Finalists will be notified via telephone or mobile and electronic mail. An official announcement will also be made on the official Facebook page of the National Council for Children's Television (fb.com/NCCT.DepEd).

#### **Awards and Recognition**

- The Top 10 entries will be featured during the DokyuBata 2018 Awarding Ceremony to be held in November 2018.
- Certificates of Recognition will be given to every production team member and the supervising adult of all finalists.

#### **Submission**

- The competition will accept submissions starting July 20, 2018. **Deadline of submission is on October 10, 2018.**
- There is no entry fee for submission.
- Each member of the production team, as well as the supervising adult, must submit a photocopy of any document of identification (e.g. valid ID, birth certificate, passport, barangay tax certificate/cedula, etc.)
- One (1) copy of the video on a DVD-R or DVD+R must be submitted.
  The video must be in .mp4 format. Aside from the .mp4 data file,
  the disc must also include three to five photos documenting the
  actual field shooting and editing of the entry.
- Must be indicated on the disc are the title of the video, production name, and city/province. The disc must be placed in a sealed short brown envelope together with the following:
  - 1. Official entry form (See attached file)
  - 2. Proof of identification of each member and supervising adult
- An envelope must contain only one entry. The envelope must be clearly labeled with the title of the video, production name, and city/province.

- All entries, whether submitted in person, via courier or online should be received by the organizers on or before October 10, **2018**, **5:00 PM**. Participants who would submit via courier are advised to notify the organizers upon sending their entries.
- Participants must shoulder the shipping cost of their submission materials.
- Receipt of entries shall be acknowledged via SMS or electronic mail. Should entrant wish to receive a Certificate of Participation for the production team members, cast, supervising adult, and school, barangay, or organization for whatever legal purpose, a prepaid self-addressed return envelope must be enclosed with the submission.

#### **Credits Guide**

- Credits must only be at the **beginning of the video**, still (nonmoving), exactly 5 seconds in length, and without background music or countdown bleep.
- All text must be of readable font size and style (e.g., Helvetica, Arial, Calibri), must be of white font color on black background, and listed in the order as in the following examples.
- Supervising adults must ensure that music used, if not an original composition of the production team members (i.e. under Creative Commons license), is properly attributed in the credits. Resource guides to fair use and proper attribution may be found online.
