SUBMISSION OF THE PRIORITY LISTS OF RECIPIENT SCHOOLS TO BE FUNDED
UNDER THE CY 2009 DEPED SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM
FOR AREAS EXPERIENCING ACUTE CLASSROOM SHORTAGE
(RED AND BLACK SCHOOLS)

1. The appropriations for the CY 2009 Red and Black School Building Program for areas experiencing acute classroom shortage will be utilized to address the classroom requirements of schools belonging to the priority red and black color coded schools of the Basic Education Information System (BEIS). Computation for the prioritization on funding allocation per legislative district (or per schools division) was based on 1:45 Double Shift classrooms-student ratio.
2. This year's school building project is part of the pump-priming program of the government in which immediate project implementation is imperative. The Special Allotment Release Order (SARO) shall only be released prior to contract award. Thus, procurement can commence even without the release of the SARO. Since this is a foreign-assisted project following World Bank procurement guidelines, posting of invitation to Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PHILGEPS) is not mandatory.
3. In preparing the final list of priority schools, please take note of the long list of red and black schools drawn from the updated Instructional Rooms Analysis of the BEIS (SY 2008-2009), the budgetary ceiling for each region, and the regionalized costing for the different project components (Annex "B"). The guidelines on the identification of recipient schools under this program are enclosed in Annex "A". Individual allocation list per Legislative District/Schools Division shall be provided by the Regional Office through the Regional Physical Facilities Coordinator (RPFC) or by the Physical Facilities and Schools' Engineering Division (PFSED) of the Central Office.
4. In preparing the allocation list, PFSED shall draw up the initial priority list from BEIS data and forward the same to the Division Physical Facilities Coordinator (DPFC) for validation of the proposed school recipients and final approval by the Schools Division Superintendent. Allocation for both elementary and high school shall not exceed the budgetary ceiling of the legislative district/schools division.

5. The Schools Division Superintendents shall be responsible for ensuring that the Congressional Representatives of their respective Divisions are informed of the list of priority schools to be recipients of this program. Enclosed in Annex "C" is the Pro-forma information letter to the Representatives.

6. The priority lists of schools shall be submitted by the Division Offices to the PFSED Office at 4th Floor Bonifacio Bldg., DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with telefax no. (02) 633-7263/638-4108/638-7110 and e-mail address at pfsed 010305@yahoo.com, following the format in Annex "D" not later than January 14, 2009. Copies of the priority lists shall be furnished the Regional Offices.

7. For those divisions which will not be able to comply with the deadline set in Item 6, the PFSED shall prepare the final list.

8. To ensure that the school buildings can be used at the start of School Year 2009-2010, President Arroyo instructed the Department to frontload the construction of school buildings during the long summer vacation period. Thus, procurement shall immediately commence right after the orientation-seminar workshops scheduled in Annex "E".

9. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Order is directed.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PREPARATION OF PRIORITY LISTS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE CY 2009 DepED SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM FOR AREAS EXPERIENCING ACUTE CLASSROOM SHORTAGE (RED AND BLACK SCHOOLS)

A. Manner of Allocation

The Lumpsum appropriation for the CY 2009 School Building Program is equitably distributed to all legislative districts on the basis of classroom shortage, as computed from the SY 2008-2009 Basic Education Information System (BEIS) and on the assumption of 1:45 double shift (1:45 DS) session.

B. Identification of Recipient Schools

1. In the identification of recipient schools for this program, priority should be given to schools that belong to the following categories:
 - a. Schools belonging to the BLACK code of the BEIS;
 - b. Schools belongs to the RED code of the BEIS;
 - c. Schools that were declared to be located in hazard prone areas and needing immediate relocation;
 - d. Schools with incomplete/partial constructions and still fall under the RED code of the BEIS;
 - e. Schools located in areas with indigenous people.
2. The identified recipient schools should have sufficient buildable space in the school site for the construction of additional classrooms. In the case of Black schools, these should have a school site with corresponding site ownership documents, (e.g. TCT, Deed of Donation, Usufruct Agreement). Tax declaration in the name of DepEd and the local government unit (LGU) will be considered by the Department as an acceptable site ownership document, provided, however, that there is a certification from the Assessor's Office that the lot has no adverse claimant.
3. To avoid duplication and the tedious process of realignment of projects, the Region/Division shall ensure the conduct of the site appraisal/validation of the proposed listing, prior to submission to the Central Office.

C. Standard Classroom Dimension

- a. 7m x 7m classroom – To be adopted for schools located in provinces where the classroom-pupil/student ratio is less than 1:45.
- b.1. 7m x 9m classroom – this will be used in schools located in semi-urban areas or in urbanizing portions of municipalities such as the poblacion where the classroom to pupil/student ratio is more than 1:45. **ALL PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS SHALL ADOPT** the 7m x 9m dimension regardless of its location and class size.
- b.2. 7m x 9m for medium-rise school building – this will be adopted for schools in the National Capital Region (NCR) and in urban or high growth areas or where the school is with limited space/site. At least a 2-storey structure shall be planned to be erected.

D. Standard Cost of School Building

The regionalized costs of school buildings are based on the prevailing cost of construction materials and hauling in a particular region. Refer to *Annex "B"* on the tabulated costs of school buildings per region.

E. Implementation Procedure

1. This pump-priming School Building Program shall be implemented through contracting using the **Principal-led School Building Program** and following the procurement guidelines of the World Bank as this project is covered in the loan agreement with the Bank under BESRA-NPSBE. Single or clustered projects amounting to \$100,000.00 or Php4,750,000.00 (using the current rate of \$1=P47.50) shall be implemented using the Principal-led SBP Scheme. Special Allotment Release Order (SARO) shall only be released upon contract award has been undertaken. Procurement can push-through without release of SARO. Since this is a foreign assisted project, posting of invitation to Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PHILGEPS) is not mandatory.
2. Single projects amounting to more than \$100,000.00 or Php4,750,000.00 shall be bidded by either Division, Region, or by Central Bids and Awards Committee using the National Competitive Bidding adopting the implementing rules and regulations of RA 9184.
3. Local Government Units (LGUs) who are interested to implement the school building projects may be allowed, upon recommendation of the Division and Regional Office, and approval by the Central Office; Provided, that a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be perfected between the Department and the LGU concerned. Assessment of the LGU shall be made to determine their capability to implement the project by Administration.

F. Coordination and Consultation

To prevent duplication of recipient schools in the Regular School Building Program (RSBP) or in any other School Building Project being implemented by other agencies and NGOs, the Schools Division/ City Superintendents or their representatives may coordinate with the concerned Representative of the Legislative District, LGU through the Local School Board, and other concerned entity, on the preparation of the final list of recipient schools.

The Schools Division Superintendent shall be responsible in ensuring that the Congressional Representatives of each respective Division are informed on the list of priority schools to be recipient of this particular program. Attached in *Annex "C"* is the Pro-forma information letter to the Representatives.

G. Reporting Format/ Submission

In preparing the list of recipient schools, the format shown in *Annex "D"* should be strictly followed. The Division Physical Facilities Coordinator (DPFC) should indicate his/her contact numbers (telephone number, fax number, cellular phone number) in the list for easy access in case clarification is needed.

It is emphasized that the final listing should be prepared in triplicate copies, the original copy to be submitted to the PFSED, duplicate copy to the Regional Office and the triplicate copy to be retained by the Division Office concerned.
