DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE PRACTICES IN EARLY LANGUAGE, LITERACY AND NUMERACY TRAINING PROGRAM

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, in compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 220, s. 2016 dated December 14, 2016 will conduct the Phase 2- Developmentally Appropriate Practices in the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy. It will be conducted in a series of five (5) Batches in 7 days each tentatively set on March, June up July 2017 which venue will be announced later.
- 2. The objectives of this activity are as follows;
 - a. capacitate the K -3 teachers and school heads on the developmentally appropriate practices in Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy; and
 - b. develop the learners' literacy and numeracy skills and attitudes which will contribute to learning to lifelong learning.

3. Expected participants of this activity are only those trainees in Phase I-ELLN, distributed
