

In consonance with Republic Act No. 10533 known as the K to 12 Basic Education Program and the major developments taking place particularly the implementation of the K to 12 Curriculum for Basic Education, there is an urgent need to enhance the existing ALS Curriculum to make it K to 12 compliant. This is a priority concern of the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) in order to harmonize the ALS Curriculum with the K to 12 formal basic education curriculum. However, in doing so, the Bureau need not lose sight of the integrative and spiraling concept/spirit of the ALS Curriculum.

The Bureau of Curriculum Development conducted the 1st part of the Workshop on the Enhancement of ALS Curriculum on September 5-10, 2016 and an In-house Review of the CO specialists on September 27-28, 2016.

In view of this, the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) through the Special Curricular Programs Division (SCPD) will conduct a **second part** of the "**Workshop on the Enhancement of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum**" on **January 16-20, 2017** at the ECOTECH Center, Cebu City for further review (by learning strand) of the 1st draft of ALS Enhanced Curriculum.
