CONDUCT OF INFORMATION CAMPAIGN TO DIFFERENT HIGH SCHOOLS

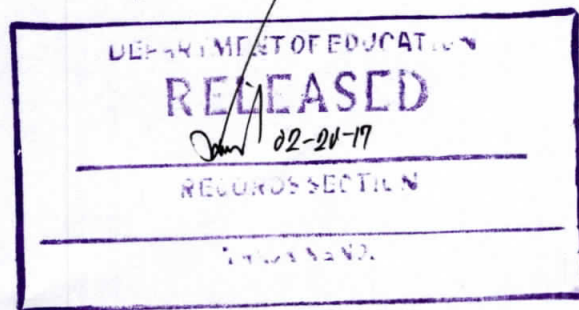
To: Schools Division Superintendents
