INTERNATIONAL COACHING COURSE BY THE UNIVERSITY OF LEIPZIG

1. This is in relation to the **International Coaching Course by the University of Leipzig** in Germany. The International Coaching Course is organized from 2020 to 2022.
2. The course will provide participants with profound and science-based knowledge, as well as competencies in the methodology of sports training. This will enable participants to:
 - a. improve their work as physical education teachers and coaches;
 - b. train athletes and teams appropriate to their age in the selected sports discipline or as a conditional coach to take care of their mental and physical preparation;
 - c. apply the acquired and in-depth knowledge, as well as their methodical competences in practical sports training under different conditions;
 - d. analyze development tendencies in their selected sports discipline and to take this into consideration when planning their own training process;
 - e. act as multipliers in the selected sports discipline, e.g. by organizing training and further education courses for sports coaches and instructors in their home country; and
 - f. promote further development of sports structures and acquisition of new target groups in the field of sports.
3. The program is open to qualified coaches and physical education teachers below 40 years old with completed higher education in the field of sports. Female applicants are highly encouraged.
4. In this connection, all DepEd regional and school division offices are encouraged to invite qualified applicants for the course.
5. The course is financed by the German Foreign Office. The qualified participants will receive a monthly allowance. However, the international airfare has to be borne by the participant/participating country.

6. The names of applicants must be submitted to the German Embassy Manila on or before **August 01, 2019**. The decision on who will be invited from the pool of qualified applicants rests with the University of Leipzig.
