CREATING ADVISORY COMMITTEES IN THE NATIONAL AND REGIONAL
CENTERS FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT
FOR LUZON, VISAYAS AND MINDANAO

1. Pursuant to Schedule 6, Paragraph 10, L.A. 544, four Centers for Technical Education and Staff Development (CTESDs) were established "to provide research and development facilities on a permanent basis." Conformably with the provisions of the said Schedule 6, Paragraph 10, it is directed for DECE to ensure that CTESDs are effectively woven in the national framework for technical and vocational education provided in Schedule 6, Paragraph 10 of L.A. 531-PHI, and that (4) CTESDs were institutionalized by virtue of MECS Order No. 1986.

2. To assist each CTESD in providing staff development and research facilities in pursuit of improving the quality of the training of middle-level technical manpower, an advisory committee to be known as TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE is hereby established in each CTESD. The functions of the Committee are to advise the Centers on the following aspects:

- a. Developing long-range goals and plans;
- b. Studying the needs of the community in education and training of middle-level technical manpower;
- c. Planning programs and developmental projects to meet the needs of the Technical Education Institutes (TEIs);
- d. Establishing linkages and collaboration mechanisms with industry, professional associations and other concerned sectors in the community;

- e. Obtaining support from the government and non-government sectors for the various programs of the Centers in the field of technical and vocational education development; and
- f. Carrying out related activities that may be deemed necessary in attaining the objectives and goals of the Centers.

3. The composition of the Advisory Committee shall include representatives of various sectors within the community served by each Center in consideration of the scope and magnitude of its functions. There shall be five (5) members of the Committee representing the following groups within the community:

- a. Industry-employment sector;
- b. Professional organizations in technical and vocational education;
- c. Technical teachers organizations/associations;
- d. Technical education institutes (TEIs); and
- e. The Executive Director of CTEED - Ex-officio member.

4. The four members must have gained recognition in their respective fields of specialization or expertise and also manifested interest in, and concern for, technical and vocational education.

5. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports upon recommendation by the top administration of the Centers shall confirm the appointments of the various Committee members including terms and conditions of their tenure.

6. The members shall elect a chairman and a vice chairman from among themselves, who shall serve gratia-et-amplius except for the refund of actual transportation and miscellaneous expenses incurred in attending consultative meetings and related affairs of the Centers.

7. This Order shall take effect immediately.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Order to all concerned is enjoined.
