MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS, AND
AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL
GOVERNMENTS, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT-
OWNED AND/OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS

SUBJECT : Deletion of Various Protective Service
Positions from the Coverage of CEC
Resolution No. 435, series of 1980

Pursuant to CEC Resolution No. 37 - 147 dated May 21, 1987, the following positions are hereby deleted from the List of Positions covered by CEC Resolution No. 435, series of 1980, namely:

Security Guard	Prison Guard
Senior Security Guard	Senior Prison Guard
Supervising Security Guard	Supervising Prison Guard
Chief Security Guard	Senior Treasury Guard
Parks and Game Warden	Forest Guard

in view of the provisions of Resolution No. 96-266 series of 1986 which states among others that the resulting eligibilities from Police Officer Examinations conducted by the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) are now considered appropriate for the corresponding or comparable level of positions in occupational groups concerned with the enforcement of laws and ordinances, prevention of crime, apprehension of criminals, and protection of life and property, and for such other positions that the Commission may determine.

Henceforth, for permanent appointment to the above-mentioned positions, the Police Officer Third Class, Security Guard or Career Service (Subprofessional) eligibility shall be required. However, change of status from Temporary to Permanent pursuant to the provision of Resolution No. 435, series of 1980, shall still be allowed if one has already been appointed to any of these positions on or before the effectivity of this Memorandum Circular.

THIS MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR TAKES EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

RESOLUTION NO. 87 - 147

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission is authorized by law to promulgate policies, guidelines and rules governing the conduct of various Civil Service examinations and the applicability of Civil Service eligibilities for purposes of appointment in the government service;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this authority, Section 2 Rule I of the Civil Service Rules provides that examinations may be assembled or unassembled and tests may be written, oral, physical, performance, testimonial or any other type which the Commission may consider to be of suitable, impartial or practical character;

WHEREAS, consistent with this provision, Resolution No. 435, series 1980 which replaced the unassembled examinations adopted a procedure whereby eligibility is granted on the basis of satisfactory performance during one year of temporary appointment to various positions which include, among others, the following:

Security Guard	Prison Guard
Senior Security Guard	Senior Prison Guard
Supervising Security Guard	Supervising Prison Guard
Chief Security Guard	Senior Treasury Guard
Parks and Game Warden	Forest Guard

WHEREAS, the main duties and responsibilities attached to these positions are principally concerned with the protection of life and government property, the successful accomplishment of which depends to a large extent on the effective use not only of one's physical capacity but also of his mental faculties especially in assessing situations and making the right decisions or actions thereon;

WHEREAS, in view of the risks involved in the performance of these duties, it is in the interest of the service that fitness of applicants for the above-mentioned positions be determined as far as practicable by competitive examination;

WHEREAS, under Paragraph 7, Section 23 of Article VI, Republic Act No. 6000, the National Police Commission is empowered to give appropriate examinations for officers and members of the local police forces;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 86-266 series 1986, the eligibilities resulting from Police Officer examinations conducted by the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) are now considered appropriate for the corresponding or comparable level of positions in occupational groups concerned with the enforcement of laws and ordinances, prevention of crime, apprehension of criminals, and protection of life and property, and for such other positions that the Commission may determine;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the Commission
RESOLVED to delete from the List of Positions under Resolution
No. 435, series of 1986, the positions of:

Security Guard	Prison Guard
Senior Security Guard	Senior Prison Guard
Supervising Security Guard	Supervising Prison Guard
Chief Security Guard	Senior Treasury Guard
Parks and Game Warden	Forest Guard

RESOLVED FURTHER, that henceforth, the appropriate
eligibility for permanent appointment to these positions shall be
Police Officer Third Class, Security Guard, or Career Service
(Subprofessional) eligibility. However, change of status from
Temporary to Permanent pursuant to the provision of Resolution
No. 435, series of 1986, shall still be allowed if one has
already been appointed to any of these positions on or before the
effectivity of this Resolution.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
