Inclosed is the set of revised guidelines and minimum standards for the operation of the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M.) program which has been recommended by the Technical Office for Agricultural Education (TPAE), Bureau of Higher Education. A series of workshops and consultative meetings with officials in the various disciplines were conducted to further review and update these standards.

The said guidelines and minimum standards approved by the Technical Office amend MECS Order No. 32, s. 1986 and shall take effect beginning this school year, 1990-1991.

All educational institutions offering such program are required to take the necessary steps in complying with the revised minimum standards.

It is desired that the inclosed guidelines and minimum standards be given the widest publicity possible.
