EMERGENCY MEASURES TO IMPROVE  
PUPIL/STUDENT PERFORMANCE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents

1. Emergency measures shall be implemented in order to obviate the possible negative effects of class suspensions caused by typhoons, earthquakes, transportation strikes (including Welga ng Bayan) during the school year, on pupil performance.

2. The Service Manual and the Manual of Regulations for Private Schools fixed the length of a school year to 40 weeks and the minimum number of days to not less than 185 (exclusive of holidays, registration days, and days of special activities).

3. Depending on the number of school days "lost", Saturday classes, shortened Christmas recess or extension of the school year to April 1991, or a combination of any or all of the aforementioned may be adopted in order that the minimum number of days can be met.

4. Information regarding the options selected should be disseminated to all concerned so that adequate preparations and planning can be done.

5. Immediate and widest dissemination possible of this Order should be made for guidance and appropriate action.
