

Dear Secretary Gloria:

We are furnishing you CESB Memorandum Circular No. 13, series of 1997, adopted by the Board en banc on 17 March 1997 reiterating the CES eligibility requirement in appointment to and/or promotion of officials in CES positions for your guidance.

The salient provisions of this MC 13 are:

1. The CES eligibility conferred by the CESB is a requirement for the appointment to and/or promotion of any person to a position in the Career Executive Service (CES);
2. In exceptional cases, the President of the appointing authority may appoint a non-CES eligible to a CES position provided, however that such appointee shall subsequently take the CES eligibility examination administered by the CESB;
3. The appointment of a non-CES eligible to a CES position shall be temporary in nature and shall not exceed twelve months;
4. A non-CES eligible appointed to a CES position shall not be promoted to a higher CES position unless he has taken and has qualified in the CES eligibility examination administered by the CESB.
