3RD NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR CAMPUS JOURNALISTS
(SECONDARY AND ELEMENTARY LEVELS, SY 2002-2003)

TO: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
School Heads/Administrators

1. Pursuant to the provisions of RA 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, mandating the Department of Education to conduct periodic seminars/training programs for campus journalists, the 3rd National Training Program for Campus Journalists shall be held on June 2-4, 2003, at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

2. The theme for the training program, as articulated in the 2003 NSPC, is **"Expanding the Reach of Campus Journalism Through Information and Communication Technology"**. Generally, the aim of the training program is to hone the students' skills in radio scriptwriting and broadcasting. Specifically, at the end of the 3-day training program, the participants shall have developed the following skills:

2.1 Radio scriptwriting

- Write news stories, feature articles, and commercials for radio broadcast;
- Practice brevity, conciseness, accuracy and objectivity in writing a news script; and
- Display creativity in radio scriptwriting and broadcasting.

2.2 Radio Broadcasting

- Read authoritatively the news, features and other elements in the new segment; and
- Speak fluently and observe proper intonation, pitch, volume and pausing in delivering the news.

3 Participants in the training program are:

- 3.1 Incoming senior editors, 15 of which are from the elementary and 15 from the secondary level (11 public and 4 private schools) from Regions III. ↗

V. VI and NCR. All other regions will send 10 elementary and 10 secondary (6 public and 4 private) participants. The Regional Office, in coordination with the regional School Paper Advisers (Elementary and Secondary) Associations, shall select the participants.

3.2 Officers of the National Secondary Editors Association and the Philippine Association of Elementary Editors Association.

3.3 Regional Supervisors (1 elementary and 1 secondary per region)

- 4 Speakers and resource persons shall be invited. The teacher-advisers will serve as facilitators, while selected BEE and BSE staff and the NSSPAA/PAESPA shall be members of the working committees.
- 5 Board and lodging of the students will be subsidized by the Journalism Fund while the travel expenses and registration fee of students and supervisors which is P500 and P1,500 respectively, shall be charged against local/school funds.
- 6 Participants shall be accommodated starting **June 2**. **The first meal to be served will be breakfast of June 2**, and the **last meal will be dinner of June 4**.
- 7 The composition of the Working Committees is in Inclosure 1, while the officers of the 2003 National Editors' Guild and the Board of Directors are listed in Inclosure 2.
- 8 Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
