**SEAMEO-RECSAM SCHOLARSHIP FOR SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS
(ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY LEVELS) FY 2004**

To: Bureau Directors

Public Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), is now accepting nominees for SEAMEO-RECSAM Scholarship in Malaysia for the school year 2004-2005.
2. Each division may submit one (1) nominee for any of the following courses:
 - PM – 0213: Using Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in Developing Primary Students' Mathematical Thinking
 - SM – 0200: Developing Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) in Secondary Science
 - AS – 1018: Action Research: Improving Teaching in Primary and Secondary Science
3. Nominees must be in excellent health and should not be more than 50 years of age. He/She must have working knowledge of computers and good at spoken and written English in order to get the maximum benefit from the course.
4. Deadline for submission of nominations together with the nominees' transcript of records, performance ratings for the last three years, service record, medical certificate from a government hospital, certification of no pending administrative or criminal case, personal data sheet (CS Form 212), photocopy of baccalaureate diploma and endorsement from the Regional Director, shall be on November 5, 2003.
