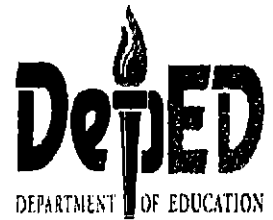

**TRAINING ON THE USE OF EXISTING MAKABAYAN MULTIMEDIA  
MATERIALS FOR THE PRIORITY STRONG REPUBLIC SCHOOL AREAS**

TO : **Bureau Directors  
Concerned Schools Division Superintendents  
Concerned Elementary and Secondary School Principals**

1. This pertains to the scheduled trainings on the use of existing Makabayan multimedia learning materials on November 18-21, 2003 at Makati City (Batch 1) and November 25-28, 2003 at Tacloban City (Batch 2). The trainings are part of the ongoing implementation of the SRS Program that aims to provide equal access to quality education in mostly marginalized, underserved and excluded school age population of the pre-identified 500 priority barangays in both the formal and alternative learning systems. The Workshop Program is in *Attachment 1*.
2. Out of the 500 pre-identified barangays/schools, 38 elementary and three high schools were identified to be the priority areas for the program implementation during the year. Enclosed is the list of the participating priority schools. (*Attachment 2*)
3. Authorized to attend are one (1) formal teacher and one (1) non-formal education facilitator from each of the priority schools, the counterpart soldier teachers (to be identified by the AFP-DND), and concerned DepEd Central Office participants (*Attachment 3*). The SDS, in coordination with the school principal, is hereby tasked to identify the participants from the school level.
4. Accommodation and traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged against SR\$ funds. The SRS secretariat will reimburse travelling expenses of participants to and from training venue subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The SRS Secretariat, c/o Aivan Leo R. Amit, Chief, PPD-OPS at (02) 6388634, will coordinate the participation of all concerned units.
