**FIRST NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
FOR TEACHERS OF EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATIONS (PATEF)**



1. The Philippine Association for Teachers of Educational Foundations (PATEF) will conduct its First National Convention with the theme "Thematic Curriculum, Special Issues and Trends in Educational Foundations" on January 15-16, 2004 at the Audio-Visual Theater, Library, Philippine Normal University, Manila.
2. The convention aims to: (a) identify researches, issues and trends concerning educational foundations; (b) share best practices in the delivery of the integrative or the thematic curriculum; and (c) cite their implications to local and global teaching competitiveness.
3. The Convention topics are as follows:
 - a. Researches and Current Issues on Educational Foundations composed of findings/recommendations of the current researches done on Educational Foundations;
 - b. Special Issues and Trends on Educational Foundations focused on the special issues and trends on Educational Foundations;
 - c. Thematic Curriculum which shows the latest and the present Philippine Educational system and best practices on implementing Thematic Curriculum;
 - d. Lecture-demo on Integrative English Curriculum; and
 - e. Workshop to develop the participants' skills on Integrative Teaching and Educational Foundations.
4. Expected participants are classroom teachers, professors of the course, Educational Foundations, administrators, supervisors and superintendents from public and private institutions.
5. Registration fee is Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP2,800.00). Early registrants can avail of a discounted registration in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP1,800.00) if a deposit of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) non-refundable fee is made on or before December 15, 2003. Participants from state/public institutions are allowed to attend **on official time only**. Those from private institutions may make arrangements with their school administrators.

6. Participants shall be entitled to receive a kit containing hand-outs, certificate of participation and attendance, PATEF regular membership and ID card, meals and snacks for two days.
