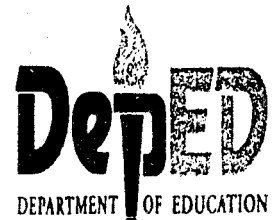

LAKBAY KONTRA SA DROGA 2004

1. The Dangerous Drugs Board, in coordination with the Department of the Interior and Local Government, Department of Education, and other concerned government agencies and non-government organizations will conduct the LAKBAY KONTRA SA DROGA 2004, a nationwide caravan to accentuate efforts of GOs and NGOs in the fight against the drug menace.
2. The Nationwide Caravan will start simultaneously on February 16 in identified areas in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, and will converge at certain cities/towns where various activities such as film showing, rallies, burning of seized drugs, among others, will be conducted. It will end on February 22, 2004.
3. All regional directors, schools division superintendents and school administrators are instructed to extend full support to the caravan thru:
  - a. holding symposia, fora, assemblies on drug abuse prevention in the school;
  - b. conduct of songwriting, slogan, poster making and declamation contests relative to drug abuse prevention;
  - c. mobilization of drum and bugle corps to provide music at kickoff and convergence points;
  - d. subject to availability of advance information on the time of arrival, selected pupils/students and scouts in schools located along the caravan route to line up along the road and wave their flaglets as the caravan passes by;
  - e. close coordination with the LGUs, other GOs and NGOs on the schedule of the caravan and activities to be conducted, especially in the areas of convergence.
4. Regional directors and schools division superintendents are enjoined to join the caravan during the time that it is within their area of jurisdiction.
5. The detailed project description, routes of the caravan and suggested responsibilities of each agency will be provided in inter-agency meetings called by DILG/PNP at the regional level.
6. Widest dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
