### TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE UTILIZATION OF ETV PROGRAMS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. This Memorandum pertains to the conduct of a regional cluster training workshop of trainors for the utilization of Educational Television (ETV) Programs. Please refer to Enclosure 1 for the tentative schedule and the regional clustering for the workshop. The training venue for each regional cluster will be announced to concerned participants at a later date.
- 2. The workshop aims to orient and train master teachers and principals of recipient elementary schools on the proper implementation and utilization of ETV programs as a means to enhance learning. Participants are expected to train teachers who will use the ETV programs in their respective schools.
- 3. The training workshop will be conducted by DepED-Central Office staff in coordination and in cooperation with the ABS-CBN Foundation, the supplier of locally produced ETV programs like *Math Tinik, Sineskwela, Bayani, Epol/Apple,* and *Hirayamanawari*. These ETV programs in DVD format, together with a TV set and a DVD player, will be given to the selected recipient schools in the twenty-eight (28) city divisions identified by the Office of Senator Francisco Pangilinan (Enclosure 2), the grantor of the financial assistance to upgrade educational facilities/equipment/materials in public elementary schools. Please refer to Enclosure 3 for the criteria in the selection of recipient schools.
- 4. The DepED-IMCS will inform the participants in writing and directly contact them or through their respective Regional/Division Offices before the workshop. Participants are expected to be at the venue at 8 a.m. on the first day of the training.
- 5. Necessary and allowable expenses for the workshop such as board and lodging of participants, venue rental, supplies, overtime pay of staff, travel expenses of facilitators and resource persons, and other incidental expenses are chargeable against the funds granted by Sen. Pangilinan for this purpose. Travel expenses of participants from the schools shall be charged against their respective budget for INSET or other allowable sources.

## Criteria for Selection of Recipients of ETV Materials/Equipment (sponsored by Sen. Francisco Pangilinan)

Each pre-identified city division will nominate a maximum of four elementary schools which may be granted ETV materials/equipment under this program. Nominated schools must:

- 1. be within the jurisdiction of the pre-identified city division;
- 2. not be a central school;
- have a complete elementary school;
- 4. not have been a recipient of similar programs;
- 5. have sustainable power supply;
- 6. be a school that needs improvement in terms of academic achievement;
- 7. have adequate security to avoid damage or loss of the equipment and materials provided; and
- 8. be willing and able to cooperate with the DepED and ABS-CBN Foundation for the successful implementation of the project.
