18<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE EDSA PEOPLE POWER REVOLUTION

To:

Regional Directors

Schools: Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- The 18th Anniversary of the EDSA People Power Revolution will be celebrated on February 25, 2004. The EDSA People Power Commission (EPPC) has designed the theme in this year's celebration as "Building Communities, Building Democracy".
- In line with the celebration, the EPPC encourages all schools and offices to initiate, organize, and/or implement community assistance and developmental activities with Volunteer Participation from students, teachers, and parents within the EDSA I celebration period (February 22-25). These activities could be joint cooperation activities among schools, Government Offices (GOs) and Non-Government Offices (NGOs).
- Suggested activities are the following: 3.
  - a. community clean up of public buildings and facilities, parks, shorelines, streets, markets, hospitals, centers, churches, schools, sidewalks:
  - b. tree planting, beautification, or construction;
  - youth assistance in medical mission, health drive, health centers and hospitals, visits to the elderly, sick and/or disabled; and
- Organized groups that could be mobilized would be youth, women organizations, church and civic organizations, PTCAs, school organizations, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, NTSP participants, etc.
- Schools and offices are encouraged to hold a flag raising commemorative activity on February 25 to mark the historic day 18 years ago when democracy and freedom were restored to the nation by the unique Filipino peaceful revolution now remembered as EDSA 1. A Prayer for the Nation and a Pledge of Commitment to Keep Filipino People Power Alive could be recited during the flag raising activity.
- The EPRC Secretariat shall be provided with information on local plans, which will be compiled and published in major dailies and announced in major radio/TV news of the EDSA Celebration. Enclosed is the Schedule of Events.

- 7. Among the confirmed EPPC activities that may be of interest and be promoted to students in Metro Manila in the Celebration on Feb. 25, 2004 are:
  - a. Launching of a Youth Caravan for Voters Education led by Youth Alliance of the Philippines, to be held at 8:00 a.m.-12:00 at St. Benilde's Gym, La Salle Greenhills;
  - b. House-building by volunteers through Gawad Kalinga with the Couples for Christ at 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 in Baseco, Port Area;
  - c. Free concert in Smokey Mountain, 3:00-5:00 p.m.
  - d. The Lakbay Kontra Droga (DDB/DILG) culminating activity on February 22, 2004 at the Quirino Grandstand coincides with the 18<sup>th</sup> EDSA I Anniversary period. Because of the spirit of volunteerism that it requires, drawing help from the people in fighting the drug menace, this activity can rightfully be coordinated with the People Power activities. It focuses on the necessity of harnessing people power to fight evils of drugs in our nation.
