**CREATING THE UNESCO/OECD WORLD EDUCATION  
INDICATORS-SURVEY OF PRIMARY SCHOOLS  
TASK FORCE**

To : **Bureau Directors

1. The UNESCO/OECD World Education Indicators (WEI) Project which is designed to deliver a small but critical mass of policy-oriented education indicators is now on its 8<sup>th</sup> year of implementation.
2. This year, the WEI project will conduct the Survey of Primary Schools (SPS), which aims to obtain cross-national information on the functioning of schools, including teaching and learning processes.
3. To provide the over-all direction and guidance that is required for the Survey, a Task Force is hereby organized to be composed of the following:

4. The Task Force shall undertake the following activities:
  - a. adapt the SPS questionnaires to the Philippine context;
  - b. supervise the selection of sample schools;

- c. coordinate with all the participating field offices schools; and
- d. supervise the conduct of the survey and processing of survey data.

5. All DepEd field offices, particularly the regional/division planning officers and heads/teachers of sample schools, are directed to provide full support to the Philippine participation in this international study. The Research and Statistics Division (RSD) of the Office of Planning Service (OPS) will provide the logistic support to the Task Force.

6. Expenses to be incurred relative to the implementation of the project shall be charged against DepEd PMIS funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
